Entry requirements	Grade 6, 6 in Combined Science or grade 6 in Physics and an average of 48 points from 8 GCSEs
Course description	The Physics A Level course includes the following subjects: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Measurements and their errors2. Particles and radiation3. Waves4. Mechanics and materials5. Electricity6. Further mechanics and thermal physics7. Fields and their consequences8. Nuclear physics9. Astrophysics
Assessment	Physics is a linear course. There are three two hour exams including a mixture of multiple choice, short and long answer questions.
Progression	Physics is a highly valued qualification, which demonstrates high level problem solving skills.
